

C-AHEAD PROGRAM

This year we are delighted to be launching C-Ahead at our conference. C-Ahead is a unique development program for accomplished female corporate senior leaders in the succession pipeline for a large P&L C-Suite position. Our cohort of 37 women were carefully selected and invited to join this highly experiential, peer-based learning program. Participants span more than a dozen industries and collectively manage more than \$45 billion in annual revenues. Our faculty is comprised of a dozen accomplished and successful corporate C200 members who will bring real world scenarios and shared experiences from their own leadership journeys to our curriculum.

Throughout the program, C-Ahead participants will engage with small teams on action-based learning modules focused on the skills critical to succeed in the C-Suite. During the sessions, C200 members serve as hosts, mentors, and partners in the learning process. This year's program runs from Wednesday, November 1st through lunch on Friday, November 3rd.





Health & Wellness Update: Female Mice Matter!

Scientific research has a gender gap, and not just among humans. In many disciplines, the animals used to study diseases and drugs are overwhelmingly male, which may significantly reduce the reliability of research and lead to drugs that won't work in half the population. The emerging knowledge that differences down to the cellular level of men and women affect their health across their lifespan-is now driving advances in the way that doctors prevent, diagnose, and treat certain conditions and illnesses.
